

Hall's website undoubtedly needed an overall revamp. The website has not been updated in recent years, after attempts at upgrading fell through as efforts on dose follow-ups regarding the upgrade planning were insufficient. Hence in mid-2015, Joey Ng added upgrading of the website into her agenda. This begins the development of our website which will come in a few phases. We started by sourcing website designers and shortlisted a few potential firms. FirstCom Solutions was appointed as they are an established local web hosting company with vast experiences in web development, along with reasonable cost and a realistic project timeline. Our target to launch the website is between six to nine months.

Phase 1 - Design Concept and Initiation of Project Confirming concept and overall layout to be used for designing entire site. Capturing comprehensive design brief through understanding all requirements in terms of functionality and design.

**Phase 2** – Designing stage Making up 'Home' page and 'About Us' page Confirming entire site design for programming Populating rest of pages for the entire site Provision of photo references.

**Phase 3** – Website Programming Development and testing of programmed website Product uploading including project photographs.

Phase 4 - Completion of website Conduct onsite training to understand backend system Launch of website. The initial start of this project was collating of all feedback from our team by FirstCom, carried out in July 2015 and involving Mok, Joey, Dolly, Esther and Amp of JHT Office through Skype conference. After a few rounds of brainstorming, the design concept was confirmed. Thereafter, Joey and Esther were actively Coordinating with FirstCom on the development of phase 2 and 3. A conscious ongoing effort was made to compile information and data for this project. We have also engaged a professional photographer to take good photographs on a few completed sites, suitable for upload on the website.

#### After revamping of website

The new look is dean and refined, in alignment with our vision to build quality. Distinct features such as 'HOME', 'ABOUT', 'PORTFOLIO', 'CLIENTELE' and 'CONTACT' are just one dick away for easy access. The focus on featuring regional portfolios exhibits Jim & Hall's core business as an interior architecture builder specialist.

The new look comes with an extension of a Content Management System platform where we self -manage the website; capable of editing content, add and remove pages, updating and uploading of project photographs to name a few. ## WHY DOES JIM & HALL'S TRACK NEAR MISSES?

Z PERSONAL RESILLT HARM DAMAGE. BY TRACKING, ANALYZING AND MANAGING REPORTED NEAR MISSES. JIM HALL'S LEARN FROM CAN THESE LESSONS AND TAKE PRE-EMPTIVE ACTION INCIDENT/ ACCIDENT HAPPEN. AND BETTER BUSINESS SENSE WORK MISSES TO UNCOVER AND DNSFT REFORE TO OUTCOMES THAT ARE BEYOND FSCALATE CONTROL.

FROM THIS OBSERVATION, HALL'S HAS CLEARLY RECOGNIZED A HAZARD CAN MANIFEST ITS PRESENCE THROUGH MISSES AND ACTION CAN TO ELIMINATE BE TAKEN MITIGATE IT. ON THE OTHER HAND, NEAR MISS HELPS MIL & ALSO æ HOLISTIC EHS CULTURE WHERE EVERYONE SHARES AND CONTRIBUTES IN A RESPONSIBLE MANNER TO IMPROVE EHS FOR THEMSELVES AND THEIR FELLOW WORKERS.

# HOW DOES JIM & HALL'S TRACK NEAR MISSES?

- 1. IDENTIFY: BRIEFING WERE CONDUCTED TO HELP ALL SITE PERSONS TO UNDERSTAND THE CONCEPT OF NEAR MISS. AND JIM & HALL'S ALSO ENCOURAGED OBSERVERS TO TAKE IMMEDIATE ACTIONS TO TEMPORARILY MITIGATE THE DANGER BEFORE REPORTING.

- 3. INVESTIGATE & INTERVENE:

INVESTIGATION WAS CONDUCTED TO EACH OBSERVATION BY JIM & HALL'S SITE EHS PERSONNEL AND FOLLOWED WITH THE IMPLEMENTATION OF PREVENTIVE ACTIONS (PERMANENT SOLUTIONS)



- 2. NO-BLAME CULTURE: ALL THE DATA COLLECTED WILL ONLY BE USED TO LEARN AND IMPROVE NOT TO BLAME OR PUNISH.



15 SECONDS

Sit in your chair, feet flat on the floor Extend one leg out in front of you, raising it as high as you can and hold for 2 seconds. Repeat 15 times on each leg





Stand at your desk and place your palms on the desk with your fingers facing towards you. Keep your arms straight and lower your body until you feel the stretch.

### SPINAL TWIST

Sit tall in your chair, feet together. Put your left hand on the desk, hold the lower back of your chair with your right hand and twist to the right. Hold for 10 seconds. Release and repeat the twist in the other direction





Push your chair away from your desk and put your leg up on another chair or furniture of similar height to your chair.
Flex your foot and lean forward (keeping your back straight).
Hold for 10 seconds. Release and repeat with your other leg.







Keep your ankles loose by lifting your foot slightly off the ground and rotating each one clockwise and anti-clockwise. This is great for preventing pins and needles.



#### 6 SHOULDER BLADES

Sit up straight, holding the seat of your chair and roll back your shoulders until the shoulder blades are pinched together.





## **CORE STRENGTHENER**

Sit straight in your chair with your feet hovering above the floor and hold onto the edge of your desk with your fingers. With your core muscles engaged (rather than your arms) swivel your chair from side to side







Stand behind your chair, hold onto the back for support. Bend your knee and slowly kick your left foot up towards your bum, then lower it and repeat with the other leg.
